

AZDHS Product Labeling Requirements

Meeting the December 31st, 2023 Label & Packaging Requirements

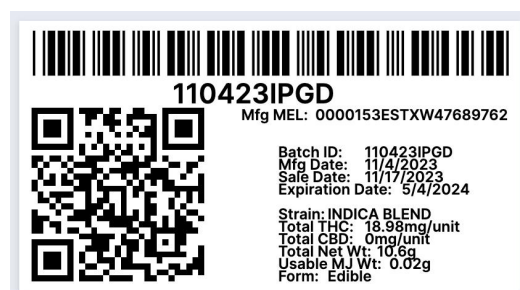
In October 2023, the Arizona Department of Health Services (AZDHS) updated the rules for marijuana product labeling. Those changes, highlighted below, have been implemented by Halo Infusions to meet these new statutory requirements. This quick reference sheet highlights the latest rule requirements and Halo Infusions compliance.

Changes to the Prior Rules

Prior to the adoption of the October 1, 2023 Rules, Arizona Marijuana Establishments and their sublicensees were required to follow the previous Draft Rules. The key differences between the prior rules and the latest rules relate to additional label information requirements and incorporation of a Quick Resource Code (QRC), containing a web link. The information required by these rule changes includes:

- The Marijuana Establishment License #
- Marijuana Source Supplier License #
- The Harvest Date of the Marijuana (if applicable)
- The Amount, Strain, and Batch # of the product
- The Form of the Marijuana product (flower, extract, edible, etc.)
- The Weight of the Marijuana product
- Potency Test Results, including THC, CBD, and other label claims
- The Method of Extraction
- The Marijuana product's Manufacture Date
- License Numbers for the Marijuana Establishment selling the product
- The Arizona Department of Health Services Warning
- The additional Warning: *"Using marijuana during pregnancy could cause birth defects or other health issues to your unborn child."*

Further to AZDHS Rules, Halo Infusions incorporates a QRC Code on all products it manufactures. The QRC Code is located on the Package (Zebra) Label and would appear similar to this:



As confirmed by AZDHS, all information required by the October 1, 2023 Rules are included on either the Package (Zebra) Label on each product, or on a website accessible from a QRC code. The reverse side of this document provides a one-to-one matching of rule requirements to the Halo Infusions Testing Web page and its contents.

R9-18-310. Product Labeling and Packaging

A. A marijuana establishment shall ensure that marijuana or a marijuana product provided by the marijuana establishment's retail site to a consumer:

1. Complies with packaging and labeling requirements in A.R.S. §§ 36-2854.01 and 36-2860(A);
2. Is labeled with:
 - 6** a. The **marijuana establishment license number**; [See Zebra Label](#)
 - b. The **amount, strain, and batch number of the marijuana or marijuana product**; [See Product Label](#)
 - c. The **form** of the marijuana or marijuana product;
 - d. As applicable, the **weight of the marijuana or marijuana product**; [See Product Label](#)
 - e. In compliance with Table 3.1, the **potency of the marijuana or marijuana product**, based on the results of testing by a marijuana testing facility, including the number of milligrams per designated unit or percentage of:
 - 11** i. **Total tetrahydrocannabinol**, reported according to R9-18-408(F)(2)(a);
 - ii. **Total cannabidiol**, reported according to R9-18-408(F)(2)(b); and **11**
 - iii. **Any other cannabinoid for which the marijuana establishment is making a claim** related to the effect of the cannabinoid on the human body; [See Product Label](#)
 - f. The following statement: **"ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES' WARNING: Marijuana use can be addictive and can impair an individual's ability to drive a motor vehicle or operate heavy machinery. Marijuana smoke contains carcinogens and can lead to an increased risk for cancer, tachycardia, hypertension, heart attack, and lung infection. Marijuana use may affect health of a pregnant woman and the unborn child. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN"**; [See Product Label](#)
 - g. For a marijuana product, the ingredients in order of abundance; and
 - h. As required by A.R.S. § 36-2854.01 and not later than December 31, 2023, a quick response code [linking to a webpage](#) that contains the following:
 - 1** i. The **strain of the marijuana**; **8**
 - ii. The following statement: **Using marijuana during pregnancy could cause birth defects or other health issues to your unborn child**; **17**
 - iii. Distribution chain information, including:
 - (1) The **name of the marijuana establishment**; **5**
 - (2) If not cultivated by the marijuana establishment, the name and the license number or registry identification number, as applicable, of the marijuana establishment or dispensary that cultivated the marijuana; and
 - (3) If not infused or prepared for sale by the marijuana establishment, the name and the license number or registry identification number, as applicable, of the **marijuana establishment or dispensary that infused or prepared** the marijuana product for sale; **2 5 6 16**
 - iv. A **link to the final report of testing marijuana or a marijuana product**, specified in R9-18-410(B)(3), from a marijuana testing facility; **13**
 - v. If applicable, the **method used to extract tetrahydrocannabinol from the marijuana**; and **4**
 - vi. The date of:
 - (1) Harvest of the marijuana; and
 - (2) **If applicable, manufacture of the marijuana product**; and **7 9**
3. Is placed in child-resistant packaging on exit from the marijuana establishment.
- B. If a marijuana establishment provides marijuana cultivated, or a marijuana product infused or prepared for sale, by the marijuana establishment to another marijuana establishment or to a dispensary, the marijuana establishment shall ensure that:
 1. The marijuana or marijuana product is labeled with:
 - a. The marijuana establishment license number;
 - b. The amount, strain, and batch number of the marijuana or marijuana product; and
 - c. The dates of:
 - i. **Harvest or sale**; and
 - ii. If applicable, **manufacture**; and **7**
 2. A copy of results of testing by a marijuana testing facility for the marijuana or marijuana product is provided to the receiving marijuana establishment or dispensary.

 - 10** Extra Information, Not Required by AZDHS Dow **14** PDF viewer
 - 12** Summary for Convenient Reception **15** Download as single PDF (for convenience)

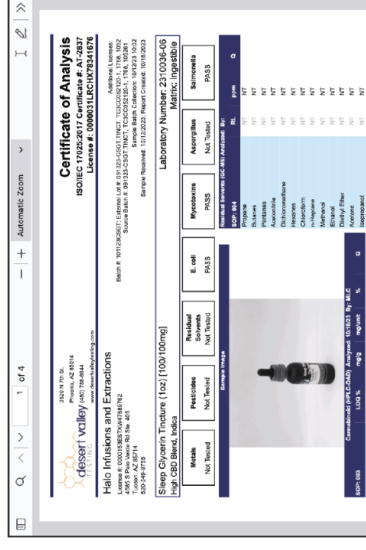
